RACING REVIEW

ALHAARTH'S AWZAAAN LOOKS STAR MATERIAL

There were some eye-catching juvenile performances on both sides of the Channel yesterday. At Newbury, Hamdan Al Maktoum's homebred **Awzaan** put up a high-class display in the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes, which attracted quotes of 12-1 for next year's 2,000 Guineas. The dark bay son of **Alhaarth** was initially settled at the rear of the field, before powering past his rivals to win with ease.

He will now head to the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes in less than a fortnight's time. A son of the Listed Eternal Stakes winner **Nufoos (Zafonic)**, he comes from the immediate family of the influential broodmare **Pelting (Vilmorin)**.

In France, His Highness The Aga Khan's homebred **Behkabad** was equally impressive, coming with a late thrust to take the Gr.3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp. The son of **Cape Cross** is now unbeaten in three starts, having won previously at La Teste de Buch and Deauville. He is a half-brother to the Listed winner **Beheshtam (Peintre Celebre)**, while his second dam is the Gr.1 Prix Saint-Alary winner **Behera (Mill Reef)**.

There were a pair of two-year-old debutant races over a mile on the same card, which have been won in the past by the likes of **Tamayuz** and **Zarkava**. This year's winners may not turn out to be of that calibre but **Royal Revival (King's Best)** and **Wedding March (Dalakhani)** both won well to give their owner Sheikh Mohammed and trainer Andre Fabre a debutant double.

At Ayr, **Distinctive** may have been a 33-1 shot in the Gr.3 Firth of Clyde Stakes but she won in the manner of a much more fancied runner. Taking advantage of the draw bias and racing on the far side rail, she sprinted clear of her rivals to win well. The daughter of **Tobougg** is owned and bred by Gary and Mrs Middlebrook and is from a family who have done well in North America and include the Graded winner **Marshua's River (Riverman)**.

According to trainer Bryan Smart, she is likely to stay further than yesterday's six furlongs, and will take her chance in some of the Guineas trials next year.

Elsewhere, the Jeremy Noseda-trained **Strike The Deal** landed his first Group victory for two years, when winning the Gr.3 World Trophy at Newbury. The four-year-old son of **Van Nistelrooy** finished fast to catch the long time leader **Total Gallery (Namid)** close home. Though the winner of the Listed Scarborough Stakes winner last time out, **Strike The Deal** won his last Group race back in 2007, when he was victorious in the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes.

According to his trainer, he is likely to reappear quickly next week in the Gr.2 Diadem Stakes at Ascot, ground permitting.

Bred by Five-D Thoroughbreds, he was bought by William Slattery for \$40,000 at Fasig-Tipton's Kentucky July Yearling Sale, for 140,000gns at Tattersalls Craven Breeze-Up Sale by Anthony Stroud and for 480,000gns at the 2007 Tattersalls December Sale by Kerri Radcliffe.

From a family peppered with European Group winners, including the Champion Miler and sire **Solford**, Italian Classic winner and sire **Giovane Imperatore** and the Gr.1 Yorkshire Oaks winner **Punctilious**. His yearling half-brother by **Eurosilver** is catalogued as **Lot 322** in Tattersalls October Yearling Sale Book One.

The Listed Doonside Cup Stakes at Ayr was won by Godolphin's **Prince Siegfried**, who beat his stablemate

Baila Me (Samum), who was having her first run this season. This was the first Stakes win for the son of **Royal Applause**, who was beaten a head by **Zafisio** in last year's Gr.1 Criterium International. Then trained by Andrew Balding, he was subsequently acquired by Godolphin.

Bred by Haras Saint Pair du Mont, he was bought for 38,000gns by Balding at Tattersalls October Yearling Sale Book One. He is the best foal of his dam **Intrum Morshaan (Darshaan)**, who is a half-sister to the Gr.3 Hillsborough Stakes winner **Coney Kitty (Lycius)**, from the family of the Champion racehorse and Classic sire **Halling**. His yearling half-brother by **Refuse To Bend** is catalogued as **Lot 1249** in Tattersalls October Yearling Sale Book Two.

The Gr.3 Prix du Prince d'Orange on the Longchamp card was won by **Cirrus des Aigles**. The three-year-old son of **Even Top** has been extremely consistent, never failing to finish out of the first three in 17 of his 18 starts. The winner of the Listed Grand Prix de Lyon d'Angers in August, this was his first win at Group level.

Bred by Yvon Lelimoizin and Benoit Deschamps, he is the fourth foal of his dam **Taille de Guepe (Septieme Ciel)**, who comes from the family of the Gr.3 Prix La Rochette winner and sire **Banjer (Baldric)**.

SO YOU THINK ADDS TO CHAPARRAL'S GROUP WINNERS

Coolmore's **High Chaparral** was the only current shuttle sire to taste success in Australasia yesterday. The Derby winner's three-year-old New Zealand-bred son **So You**

Think was the cosy winner of the Gr.3 Gloaming Stakes at Rosehill in Australia. A NZ\$110,000 New Zealand Bloodstock Premier Yearling Sale graduate, he was bred by M J Moran and Piper Farm and is out of the Gr.2 Sir Tristram Fillies Classic winner **Triassic (Tights)**, from the family of the New Zealand Gr.3 winner **Red Card (Red Tempo)**.

Racing Preview

NORTH AMERICA

JUDDMONTE PAIR SEEK WOODBINE DOUBLE

The eyes of Northern Hemisphere racing fans will be firmly locked on Canada this evening when Woodbine stages the weekend's only Gr.1 races this side of the equator. And there may well be a strong case of *deja' vu*, with both 2008 winners defending their crowns.

Both races are on turf and Juddmonte homebred **Champs Elysees** goes first in the 12-furlong Northern Dancer Stakes, in which the six-year-old **Danehill** entire faces nine rivals. A full-brother to **Banks Hill**, **Intercontinental**, **Cacique** and **Dansili**, he has certainly maintained the family tradition and is seeking a third Gr.1 success. He will need to uphold last year's form over **Quijano** (second) and **March Side** (fourth).

German representative **Quijano**, now seven, is a seasoned international performer and has won in Italy and Dubai as well as his native land. A son of **Acatenango**, he has three Gr.1 victories on his cv.

Champs Elysees's most recent start was a second in the Gr.2 Sky Classic Stakes and he again meets his conqueror **Marchfield**, a five-year-old entire son of **A P Indy**, on worse terms tonight.

Marsh Side (**Gone West**), **Just As Well (A P Indy)** and former Pascal Bary inmate **Musketier (Acatenango)** are all feared in what appears a wide open contest.

Ten have also been declared for the Woodbine Mile in which last year's hero, **Rahy's Attorney**, a five-year-old **Rahy** gelding, is also opposed by the horse he beat last year. The horse in question, **Ventura**, is another Juddmonte homebred on what could be a good night for the operation.

On his penultimate start, **Rahy's Attorney** defeated both **Marchfield** and **Champs Elysees**, before arguably disappointing behind the same pair last time, so a big run from them would boost his form claims.

Ventura, a five-year-old daughter of **Chester House**, is seeking a third Gr.1 win and has thrived since leaving the UK.

Another recruit from Europe is **Ferneley** and this five-year-old **Ishiguru** entire was a Gr.2 winner most recently. This looks a lot tougher though and **Bribon (Mark of Esteem)** looks a bigger danger. Formerly campaigned in France, he was a Gr.1 winner last time and arrives from his New York base in great heart.

Jungle Wave (Hold That Tiger) and **Sand Cove (Bold Executive)** may prove best of the rest.

KEENELAND – EARLY LOTS

RYAN SNAPS UP TOP THREE EARLY LEADERS

Two yearlings starred during early trading on the fifth day of Keeneland's September Yearling Sale, selling for \$350,000. The first through the ring was **Lot 1287**, a colt from the second crop of **Afleet Alex**, who was bought by Mike Ryan, as agent. Consigned by Dromoland Farm, as agent, he is a half-brother to several winners out of **Swift Princess (Meadowlake)**. She is a half-sister to the Stakes winner **Gold Wonder (Golden Missile)**, from the family of the Gr.1 winners and sires **Roman Ruler (Fusaichi Pegasus)** and **El Corredor (Mr Greeley)** and the new sire **Maimonides (Vindication)**.

Some twenty lots later, Ryan snapped up a colt by **Stormy Atlantic, Lot 1310** for the same amount. Consigned by Peter O'Callaghan's Woods Edge Farm, as agent, he is the second foal of his dam **Underworld (Unbridled's Song)**. She won at three and is a half-sister to the Stakes winner **Candy Jo (Maria's Mon)**.

In between, Ryan went to \$320,000 for **Lot 1301**, a colt by **Tiznow**, who was also consigned by Woods Edge Farm. He is the second foal of his dam, the Stakes winner **Tingwithasting (Wild Rush)**. She is out of the multiple Stakes winner **Notable Sword (Crusader Sword)**, a half-sister to the Listed winner **Diablo's Notably (Diablo)**.

NORWAY

FUNNY LEGEND BROTHER TO STAR AT MERIDIAN SALE

The next yearling sales in Scandinavia is that held at the picturesque Meridian Stud in the southern part of Norway, where twenty yearlings, the same number as last year, will come under the hammer next Saturday.

There has been a sizeable decrease in the number of yearlings offered for sale in Norway, compared to the 38 two years ago, while in 2003, 41 yearlings came under the hammer. This shows to a degree, the fact that Norwegian racing has become heavily reliant on international imports this year.

Funny Legend (Funambule), is without doubt the yearling most likely to grab the attention of buyers. However, others to catch the eye include the well-bred **Royal Experiment** colt, who is out of **Folita (Lomitas)**, a half-sister to the Gr.2 winner **Kill The Crab (Petorius)** and the Listed winner **Killaden (Barathea)**, a filly by the same sire out of the dual Listed and Classic winner **Final Care (Caerleon)** and a **Septieme Ciel** filly out of the winner **Theatre Hall (Cajun Cadet)**, who is a half-sister to the new Scandinavian star **Theatrical Award (Academy Award)** and the Danish Derby winner **Mission Impossible (Groom Dancer)**. www.bongoracing.dk

The field split into two, headed by **Beyond Desire (Invincible Spirit)** on the stands' side, while **Astrophysical Jet (Dubawi)** led the far side group. It soon became evident that the far side held the advantage and, approaching the final furlong, **Distinctive (Tobougg)** began to make headway, sailing past her rivals and running on strongly to win comfortably by three and three parts of a length.

Third on her debut at York, **Distinctive** won at the second time of asking in a Redcar maiden last month.

Before yesterday's Gr.1 Underwood Stakes, **Heart Of Dreams'** trainer Mick Price didn't know whether to set the Australian Guineas winner for a tilt at the W S Cox Plate or aim a bit lower and target the Toorak Handicap two weeks before. It now looks to be all systems go for Moonee Valley and Australia's weight for age championship after the gelding ground out a victory at Caulfield yesterday.

Positioned just behind the pace, rider Craig Newitt brought the son of **Show A Heart** to the middle of the track, where they made their charge along with the favourite **Whobegotyou**. The move was a smart one as there turned out to be trouble inside with **Vigor** and **Red Ruler** not enjoying the best of luck. Heart Of Dreams got first run and neither he nor Whobegotyou really sprinted, instead the pair ground it out, collaring **Predatory Pricer** near home. In the end the winning margin was a neck with a short head back to Predatory Pricer in third.

The race was full of excellent runs for the future. Raining Melbourne Cup favourite Vigor finished sixth without luck and Red Ruler plugged on for fifth. But the two eye catching runs came from the past two Melbourne Cup winners. Both **Efficient** and **Viewed** stayed on well from the back in a race not run to suit them. Connections will be pleased with their progress towards the first Tuesday in November.

Heart Of Dreams' sire Show A Heart won Gr.1 races at each of his four seasons on the track. Probably the best was his win here at Caulfield in the Caulfield Guineas, so it is no surprise to see his son take a liking to the track.

It was a big day for Heart Of Dreams' dam **Academy Of Dreams**. Not only did she produce a Gr.1 winner but earlier in the card his year older full-brother **Rightfully Yours** landed a Listed sprint. **Dream About It**, grandam of Heart Of Dreams was a useful daughter of **Godswalk**, the winner of nine, including the Listed Ballarat Cup. Her dam **Black Tokk** was a French foaled daughter of **Blakeney** and the dam of the Gr.1 Goodwood Handicap winner **French Clock**. Another of her foals was the Listed winner **Ladybird Blue**, who was second in the Gr.1 South Australian Oaks.

Alynda then produced the Group winner **Alinsky** and the Listed winners **Capestad**, **Altrista** and **Zalinda**, the latter foaling the Gr.3 winning sprinter **Fast 'N' Famous**. Another daughter of Betty Box was **Jewel Box**, whose granddaughter is the Gr.1 Captain Cook Stakes winner **Penny Gem**, whilst the Gr.1 VRC Derby winner **Hit The Roof** also has Betty Box as her grandam being out of Good News.

The race was marred by an incident at the start where the heavily backed **Gold Salute** reared and dislodged his rider as the starter let the field go. The Sheikh Mohammed owned filly **Estee** in the adjacent stall was interfered with by Gold Salute and both horses were declared non runners by the stewards on the grounds of having been denied a fair start.
