Ensure that advanced life support (ALS) has been requested and monitor response time	1	
Demonstrates the administration of high concentration of oxygen	1	
Properly positions the patient	1	
Initiates steps to prevent heat loss from patient	1	
Indicates need for immediate transportation	1

CRITICAL CRITERIA:

- ___ Did not take or verbalize body substance isolations precautions
- ___ Did not administer high concentration oxygen
- ___ Did not control hemorrhage using correct procedures in a timely manner
- ___ Did not recognize hypoperfusion
- ___ Did not indicate a need for immediate transportation
