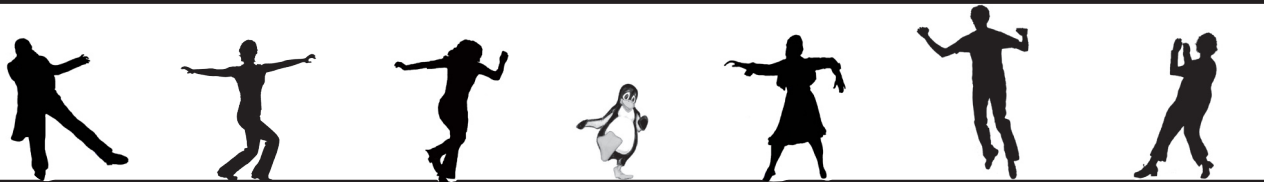

- ★ Early registration is strongly recommended, as class sizes are limited. Also, classes not meeting minimum enrollment by June 22 may be cancelled.
- ★ There is a \$20 non-refundable registration fee for NEW STUDENTS ONLY.
- ★ Payments accepted in cash or by check. There will be a \$25 fee for returned checks.
- ★ No partial payments will be accepted.
- ★ Tuition is nonrefundable after the first day of class. If you request a refund prior to the start of the term, there is a \$25 processing fee.
- ★ Missed classes must be made up in the current session.
- ★ For the welfare of our floors, we do not allow nail-on taps except in the cases of our youngest students. All older children and adults must wear shoes with screw-on taps.
