FLORIDA MARRIAGE LICENSE SERVICES FOR DESTINATION WEDDINGS

NOTE TO NOTARY/SOLICITOR

To insure the documents are properly executed, using black ink only, notary must clearly print name and expiration date. Sign and seal all documents requiring notarization. **PLACE ONLY ONE NOTARY STAMP FOR BOTH SIGNATURES WHERE INDICATED ON APPLICATION TO MARRY. THE ONE NOTARY SEAL MUST BE PLACED IN THE MARGIN TO THE LEFT OF THE BRIDE AND GROOM SIGNATURES - DO NOT PLACE YOUR STAMP OR SEAL OVER ANY PART OF THE MARRIAGE LICENSE INFORMATION OR THE SIGNATURES.**

The notary will administer the oath and continue as follows:

- Groom must confirm information is accurate on license and sign full name in black ink in box #9 (*in presence of notary or solicitor*).
- Bride must confirm information is accurate on license and sign full name in black ink in box #13 (*in presence of notary or solicitor*).
- Notary/Solicitor to print the date in boxes #10 and #14 and sign in black ink in boxes #12 and #16. Notary/Solicitor will print their name and commission expiration date, if applicable, in boxes #11 and #15.
- Notary will place ONE notary seal when notarizing bride and groom's signature in area indicated on top left margin only (the lower notary designation is reserved for the person performing the ceremony). Please do not cover any portion of the marriage license or signatures with seal. If seal is too large for the area, please affix the seal before the bride and groom sign to avoid covering any signatures. A rectangular shaped seal may be placed sideways on the space provided.

REQUIRED PREMARITAL STATEMENT

- Bride and groom will print and sign in the appropriate spaces.

NOTARIZED COPIES OF THE DRIVER'S LICENSE OR PASSPORT

- Notary will attest to copies of bride and groom's identification (passport or U.S. driver's license), making sure copies are legible.
